

## **GOALS AND OBJECTIVES**

**January 29, 2018**

### **Goal #1 - To provide bursaries for mature women on the Sunshine Coast to enable them to further their education and training:**

- raise \$5000 for the Bursary Fund by organizing a 10k run/walk-a-thon (funds raised from entry fees, pledges and participants' barbecue)
- develop and implement "Cookies for College" to be held annually on IWD: a cookie cook-off country fair style judged by local chefs and used to launch the CFUW-SC's Annual Bursary Program

### **Goal #2 - To sustain a robust organization which supports friendship and a sense of community:**

- organize a fund-raising event that supports the Bursary Society's purposes and requires face-to-face collaboration of CFUW members ("I Can't Believe She Wore That! CFUW brings 150 years of women's fashion to the Coast")
- compile a list of past Bursary winners and invite them to attend meetings as guests/members/speakers/mentors (coordinate with CFUW National who is compiling a list Canada-wide)

### **Goal #3 - To advocate on issues which support the purposes of CFUW National:**

- in partnership with local groups, coordinate a workshop exploring both sides of the implementation of a living wage on the Sunshine Coast

### **Goal #4 - To provide educational opportunities for members and the community:**

- launch a workshop series "Women Move Up!" provided free for the community to explore opportunities for women's personal and educational growth. Where possible, use the skills and abilities of members as facilitators

### **Goal #5 - To provide opportunities for members to use their skills, talents, and experience:**

- organize an annual event gathering local greenery, hold a members' work party to assemble Christmas swags, and sell the swags at various venues on the Sunshine Coast with proceeds going to the Bursary Fund ("Swag Ladies")
- create a pool of CFUW mentors available to support Bursary applicants/winners
